Hello and welcome to the third edition of our Junior Section Newsletter.

The First Tee will be booked at a regular time between 13.30 and 13.50pm every Saturday. Can everyone playing between these times have their score card filled in and be ready to tee off promptly.

Could all players / guardians please note, that during the playing sessions out on the course, we may feel it beneficial for the player to attend Gary's teaching school for a short period to enable Gary to iron out any shortfalls that have been identified in their game. Teaching School
