The weather was horrible to start with but by the end of the morning 9 holes it had dried up and remained dry for the afternoon 18 holes. The course was immaculate and the food was lovely.

UK Blind Championship / Charity Day

Great news for NGC and in particular Andrew Sellars in that he recently won the 2024 English blind golf match play championship. Andy was five down after five holes in the final but came back strongly to win on the 18th. Andy is now currently lying in first place on this year's order of merit. Well done Andy!

Andy continued his good form by winning the next Blind Golf Event, the Jack Kerfoot Cup and then finished Runner Up in the Matchroom EP Stableford Trophy shooting 38 points in both events and now 13 points clear on the Order of Merit. Andy is looking forward to defending the English Blind 36 hole Medal National Championship in July with fellow member Oliver Durham guiding him

Andy Sellars also holds a very large and successful Charity Day every year at NGC and this year on 11th June in his 11th year of hosting it was no exception with 119 sighted Golfers playing. This year it raised £19,172 for the Yorkshire Air Ambulance and in the 11 years it has raised over £182,000 for Charity. Absolutely brilliant!!

72 hole Charity Event PoW Hospice

One of our members Stuart Sterling has just completed a 72 hole golf challenge to raise money for the Prince of Wales Hospice. Stuart's partner recently lost her mother and the Prince of Wales Hospice provided exceptionally care whilst looking after her. The first tee shot was struck in torrential rain at 04.37 am with the final putt being sunk in glorious sunshine at 16.59pm. Stuart would like to thank any members who either sponsored him on my just giving page or via the collection tins around the course as well as the ones who donated to him on his way round.

He has raised £570 from sponsorship and £435 from his work, totalling just over £1k which his work will double to make it £2k for the charity, which is an exceptional effort by Stuart, well done!!


If you are unable to attend the event but would still like to take part, speak to one of the pro staff about dropping off your equipment in advance and we can deal with the rest for you.


