Members may have read through these Newsletters over the last few years about the recent success of our Junior and Academy Section, having won 3 leagues and 4 promotions in total over the last three seasons, as well as reaching the Junior Cup final last year. The Academy set-up continues to grow and has Golf Sixes and NRL 'nines' to play in as they develop their skills.

All this is from having virtually no juniors several years ago. This has been a real "NGC team" effort to get where we are now running 2 successful LDGU Junior League teams, and has been achieved through the enormous commitment of Kay Allsop, backed up by keen enthusiastic parents/grandparents and supported all along the way by the Professional team of Gary, Callum and Rich Law, who have played a key role in the delivery of coaching the academy children. The Board of Directors have backed the development all the way. It just goes to prove what can be achieved when we all pull together as a team.

This initial success now requires strategic development as it moves in to the next phase. Part of that development has seen a change in Junior Organiser, with Kay passing the baton over to Paul Mottram. The Juniors are now being run by a team of parents and older players, particularly the current and ex-Captains, with Paul being the point of contact for the club. One of the first new initiatives is to implement a coaching system for the junior players, in addition to that used with the academy children.

This will be led by Rich Law in partnership with the individual coaches that any of the players may have, with a view to keeping future development 'in-house' and making Normanton a force in the junior game. Furthermore, future Captain's will have more responsibilities within the section. These ideas, and a number of others, are all work in progress.
