Chris (Finance Director) announced another year-end deficit once more, emphasising that it isn't sustainable in the longer term. However he expressed more confidence regarding this year's financial position following an excellent golfing season weather wise.

Andy (Greens Director) stated that in his short time of having responsibility for the Course, he had become all too aware (as Andy Hall had told him) of what an influence the weather has on our ability to develop the course as we would like and that although this year has been ideal for playing golf it's been somewhat of a nightmare (lack of rain/water) to maintain the course in the condition that we would like.

Harold (House Director) said that we were in the process of replacing Chris (Chef who left end of September) and also gave thanks to Sarah who was leaving, for all her hard work on the hospitality side of things. Harold listed some of the House improvements that had taken place and stated that other essential improvements would continue this year.

Gary (Membership Director) showed a chart comparing subs with other local Clubs and said the introduction of more flexible membership packages had been a success.

Rich (Marketing Director up to recently) took us through the members survey showing the key outcomes from members views.

Paul (Golf Director) described several golfing initiatives, (particularly competitions) that had been tried throughout the year and said he was always willing to listen to any member ideas put forward.



I challenged us to reach the milestone of £10K donated to The Alzheimer's Society on Saturday at our presentation competition and awards ceremony. I am thrilled to announce that "we did it". In fact our Normanton Golfing Family, along with friends and family smashed the target.

We needed almost £600 to reach the target but instead we raised just over £1000. £87 was raised at the 10th Charity Hole with Janet West winning a bottle of spirits and a box of Callaway Golf balls, having hit her ball within 70cms. Almost £700 was raised from the raffle and £190 from the auction of 4 balls, along with bits and pieces donated such as our professional Richard Law donating £20

This money has been paid direct into my JustGiving page and is therefore available to the society with immediate effect.

The total raised to date is £10,522. I cannot express my gratitude enough, your generosity has truly touched my heart.
